A **turtle** was spotted here! It eats mushrooms and seeds in spring and summer.



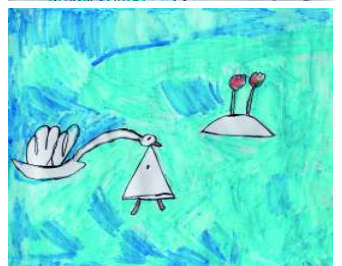
4. LOOK!
